**A reminder:** If you plan to participate in the Show 'n Shine (judged class), you will need to have your car through tech check and classification **by Friday at 5:00 p.m.** Judging will begin early Saturday morning and there will not be time to tech check or classify any cars in the morning. Also, if you are entering your car in Show 'n Shine, there is a **mandatory drivers and judges meeting** on Friday at 3:00 p.m. This is especially important if this is your first time showing a vehicle in our show. **Also, ALL vehicles are to have their photo taken, whether you are in Show 'n Shine or a Cruiser!** The photos are needed for awards and event coverage in the *Chevy Classics* magazine.

We have once again decided to implement the assigned parking program. For those not familiar with this system or those that need a refresher on how it works – here goes:

Once you have your packet, find the parking space you want that does not have a red dot already on it and place the large red dot found in your packet on your chosen numbered space. With your window card in hand, go to the "Assigned Parking" table and let them know the space you have chosen so it can be marked on the layout board and on your window card. If you put your dot down on a space and do not go to have it recorded on the layout board, that space is still up for grabs. It does not belong to you. Once you have registered your space, do not move your vehicle to another space prior to judging!
